6 ASSISTANCE GRANT (“JAG”) PROGRAM THROUGH THE BROWARD
7 SHERIFF’S OFFICE (“BSO”) IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-EIGHT
8 THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINE DOLLARS AND NO/100
9 (\$28,809.00); A COPY OF THE 2025 FLORIDA LOCAL JAG ALLOCATIONS IS

12 RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING
13 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) Program is a
16 federal funding opportunity administered by the United States Department of Justice to support
17 a range of public safety initiatives, including law enforcement, crime prevention, equipment
18 acquisition, and training;

19 WHEREAS, the Broward Sheriff’s Office (“BSO”) serves as the lead agency for the
20 administration and distribution of JAG funds within Broward County;

21 WHEREAS, for the 2025 funding cycle, an allocation in the amount of Twenty-Eight
22 Thousand, Eight Hundred and Nine Dollars and No/100 (\$28,809.00) has been identified for
23 potential award to the City of Lauderdale Lakes (“City”);

24 WHEREAS, participation in the JAG Program will enable the City to enhance public safety
25 capabilities through eligible expenditures such as equipment acquisition, crime prevention
26 initiatives, and other law enforcement purposes consistent with program guidelines, without
27 impacting the City’s general fund;

28 WHEREAS, the grant application deadline is April 28, 2026, and City staff seeks
29 authorization to submit the application; and

1 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
2 final passage.
