3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAUDERDALE LAKES,  
4 FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND  
5 ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY, THAT CERTAIN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (“ILA”)  
6 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAUDERDALE (“CITY”) AND BROWARD COUNTY FOR  
7 SHARING RESOURCE BURDENS OF THE SYSTEM-WIDE NPDES MS4 PERMIT;  
8 FURTHER AUTHORIZING BROWARD COUNTY TO CONDUCT TECHNICAL  
9 ACTIVITIES REQUIRED BY THE NPDES MS4 PERMIT; A COPY OF THE ILA IS  
10 ATTACHED HERETO AS **EXHIBIT A**; A COPY OF WHICH IS AVAILABLE FOR  
11 INSPECTION IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE  
12 ADOPTION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY  
13 CLERK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 WHEREAS, under the United States Clean Water Act of 1987, all local governments and  
16 public entities are required to comply with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System  
17 (“NPDES”) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (“MS4”);

18 WHEREAS, compliance is met by continuously managing, monitoring, and renewing  
19 existing stormwater pollution programs;

20 WHEREAS, an MS4 is a public system of conveyance, such as storm drains, pipes, ditches,  
21 and catch basins used to collect rainwater runoff and discharge it untreated into local waterways;

22 WHEREAS, every cycle, a new permit is issued by the Florida Department of  
23 Environmental Protection (“FDEP”), which is the entity delegated by the Utility Environmental  
24 Protection Act (“UEPA”) to implement the NPDES permitting program;

25 WHEREAS, the City of Lauderdale Lakes (“City”) is currently operating under Cycle 4,  
26 which was executed in July 2017 and was extended into Year 9;

27 WHEREAS, to obtain the permit, Broward County acts as Lead Permittee and all thirty-one  
28 (31) municipalities act as Co-Permittees;

1           WHEREAS, Broward County, as Lead Permittee, is responsible for conducting all required  
2 technical activities throughout Broward County to ensure compliance in accordance with the  
3 terms of the permit;

4           WHEREAS, all municipalities, including the City, agree to share the cost and responsibility  
5 of complying with the federal requirements alongside Broward County through an Interlocal  
6 Agreement (“ILA”) executed every five (5) years;

7           WHEREAS, the City remains in compliance with the NPDES and MS4 permit;

8           WHEREAS, the total share of the City’s obligation for the five-year term of the NPDES MS4  
9 permit is in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Nine Dollars and No/100  
10 (\$55,509.00);

11           WHEREAS, funds in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and  
12 No/100 (\$10,579.00) are included in the Fiscal Year 2027 proposed budget to cover the costs of  
13 Year 1; and

14           WHEREAS, additional funds will be incorporated yearly into the budgets for future years.

15           NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
16 LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

17           SECTION 1.   ADOPTION OF RECITALS: The foregoing RECITALS are hereby ratified and  
18 confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

19           SECTION 2.   AUTHORITY: The City Commission hereby authorizes the Mayor and City  
20 Clerk to execute and attest, respectively, that certain Interlocal Agreement between the City of  
21 Lauderdale Lakes and Broward County for the NPDES MS4 Permit, in substantially the same form

1 as attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, and incorporated herein by reference, and further authorizes  
2 Broward County to conduct technical activities required by the NPDES MS4 Permit.

3 SECTION 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk, through the Acting City  
4 Manager, is hereby authorized to obtain three (3) executed copies of the Agreement with one  
5 (1) copy of the Agreement to be directed to Broward County; with one (1) copy to be maintained  
6 by the City; and with one (1) copy directed to the Office of the City Attorney.
