10 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 218.39, Florida Statutes and Section 3.15 of the  
11 City of Lauderdale Lakes ("City") Home Rule Charter, Florida municipalities, including the City,  
12 shall have an annual financial audit of its accounts and records performed by an independent  
13 certified public accounting firm;

14 WHEREAS, the City has received its Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Annual Comprehensive  
15 Financial Report from the independent auditors, HCT Certified Public Accountant and  
16 Consultants, LLC, for the period of October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025; and

17 WHEREAS, City Staff recommends that the City Commission accept the Fiscal Year  
18 2024/2025 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report.

19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
20 LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

21 SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF RECITALS: The foregoing RECITALS are hereby ratified and  
22 confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

23 SECTION 2. ACCEPTANCE OF AUDITOR'S REPORT: The City Commission hereby accepts  
24 the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report prepared by HCT Certified  
25 Public Accountant and Consultants, LLC.

1 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
2 final passage.
