The Parks and Human Services Department is proposing to offer a structured and well-supervised Teen Skills Training program for youth in the community. The focus will be on enriching the lives of the youth in the community through interaction with Law Enforcement and other organizational partners while providing the teens with the opportunity to earn certificates for completing various courses and workshops.

The workshops will be offered for teens ages 15-19 that are in grades 9th – 12th. Eligible participants will include Lauderdale Lakes residents or students that attend local high schools. Our goals are to create an environment of safety, character building, career preparedness, academic enrichment and fun. Funding for these activities will assist in reducing risky behavior amongst youth, keeping kids off the street, deterring youth from the criminal justice system while providing them with tools that will assist in career building. Police and Fire officers of the Broward Sheriff's Office Lauderdale Lakes division will engage in these activities through open dialogue while exchanging ideas on making our community an even safer place to live.
