18	PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING AN		
19	EFFECTIVE DATE.

21	WHEREAS, the City of Lauderdale Lakes ("City") currently has servers and storage array		
22	systems which are necessary to create the ideal virtual environment to host the email server a		
23	file servers;		
24	WHEREAS, the existing email server has 32BIT hardware running windows 2008 server		
25	manufactured in 2008 by Dell Inc, and acquired by the City in 2009;		
26	WHEREAS, the server is now obsolete, and among other issues, is no longer supported by		
27	software updates;		
28	WHEREAS, in 2020, the City experienced an email server outage and the server is being		
29	hosted by another, temporary, server at slower speeds and with less storage capacity than th		
30	City requires for optimal performance;		
31	WHEREAS, the City uses this equipment regularly to conduct all of its daily operation		
32	and such equipment is vital to the continuity and efficiency of the City's operations;		

WHEREAS, the purchase of upgraded servers and other hardware will enhance the City's
ability to store data in a cloud environment, enhance the speed of emails, the operating system,
as well as allow for support and integration of future servers;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 82-358(d), of the City's Procurement Code (authorizing cooperative purchasing in public procurements of supplies, services, or construction), the Director of Financial Services has further determined that the time, expense and marketplace factors make it financially advantageous, and thus in the best interest of the City, to utilize the Dell Contract as an immediate measure to upgrade the City's servers and avoid further system failures or loss of data.

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota awarded Contract No. MNWNC-108 to Dell Marketing, LP under the Western States Contracting Alliance-National Association of State Procurement Officials Valuepoint Cooperative ("WSCA-NASPO") Purchasing Program, after a formal competitive procurement (the "Dell Contract"). The State of Florida subsequently entered into a Participating Addendum to the Dell Contract;

WHEREAS, SHI International Corp. (the "Contractor") is a Dell authorized reseller for the NASPO ValuePoint Purchasing Program. The Contractor has provided a pricing estimate for the computer equipment in the amount of Twenty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Ten and 30/100 (\$27,310.30) Dollars which includes the cost of the computer equipment, installation, technical support, and a limited warranty;

WHEREAS, City Staff is further requesting approval of an additional Two Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Nine and 70/100 (\$2,689.70) Dollars to serve as a contingency amount for any

- 1 related expenses, for a total contract purchase amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand and
- 2 No/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars; and
- 3 WHEREAS, funding for replacement of the servers, hard drives, and other computer
- 4 equipment was budgeted in the City's Fiscal Year 2021 budget, and there are adequate funds
- 5 available in the General Fund, 0010617-6410.
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
- 7 LAUDERDALE LAKES, as follows:
- 8 SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF RECITALS: The foregoing RECITALS are hereby ratified and
- 9 confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby incorporated by reference and made part of
- 10 this Resolution.
- 11 SECTION 2. AUTHORITY: The City Commission, in accordance with Article XIII, Section
- 12 82-358(d) of the City of Lauderdale Lakes Municipal Code, hereby approves, and ratifies the City
- 13 Manager's authority to enter into an agreement with Dell Marketing, LP in accordance with the
- terms and conditions of the WSCA-NASPO Contract No. MNWNC-108, in substantially the form
- as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand and No/100
- 16 (\$30,000.00) Dollars to purchase of computer equipment.
- 17 SECTION 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby instructed to
- obtain three (3) fully executed copies of the subject agreement with one (1) to be delivered to
- 19 SHI International Corp., with one (1) to be maintained by the City, and with one (1) to be directed
- to the Office of the City Attorney; and further to take any and all action necessary to effectuate
- 21 the intent of this Resolution.
