3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAUDERDALE LAKES,
4 FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
5 COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022;
6 SETTING DATE AND TIME FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE
7 AND BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING
8 FOR ADOPTION OF TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR
9 ESTABLISHMENT OF DATES, TIME AND PLACE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS;
10 PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, the City Commission of the City of Lauderdale Lakes determined
14 and adopted Resolution 2021-070 for the proposed Millage Rate for the fiscal year commencing
15 October 1, 2021 ("Fiscal Year 2022"), and further scheduled the two public hearings required by
16 Section 200.065(2)(b), Florida Statutes, the first to be held on September 15, 2021, at 5:01 p.m., and
17 the second hearing to be held on September 23, 2021;

18 WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended an annual budget for Fiscal Year 2022,
19 commencing October 1, 2021. The City Manager also recommended to adopt a separate City of
20 Lauderdale Lakes Fiscal Year 2022 tentative voted debt service millage of 1.0950 mils for a
21 combined total tentative millage rate of 9.6950; and

22 WHEREAS, the public and all interested residents, persons or parties will have the
23 opportunity to address their comments to the City Commission, and the City Commission will
24 first consider the comments of the public regarding the tentative millage rate.

25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
26 LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

27 SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF RECITALS: The foregoing RECITALS are hereby ratified and
28 confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE: There is hereby proposed to be levied upon all taxable real and personal property in the City of Lauderdale Lakes, except that property exempted under the Constitution of the State of Florida and other laws of the State of Florida, the following millage rates, on each One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of taxable value for the applicable tax year for the benefit of the City of Lauderdale Lakes:

SECTION 3. ESTABLISHMENT OF DATES, TIME AND PLACE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS: The final public hearing shall be held on September 23, 2021, at 5:01 p.m. to adopt a final millage rate and budget for Fiscal Year 2022.

SECTION 4. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk, through the City Manager, and in cooperation with the Director of Financial Services, is hereby directed to advertise the public hearing as required by law and to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Property Appraiser, Broward County Department of Finance and Administrative Services, and the Broward County Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
