

City of Lauderdale Lakes Veterans Recognition and Honor Program




Recognition Program

- ✓ Lauderdale Lakes is home to countless veterans and active military personnel.
- ✓ Recognize these heroes for their service and sacrifice to our Country and local community.
- ✓ The program will recognize up to 5 veterans or other military personnel twice a year.
- ✓ Banner of recognized veterans hung at the Mayor Samuel Brown monument for 6 months.
- ✓ Presentation at City Commission meeting (December & June).

Application Process:

- ✓ Available on City's website and in hard copy at City facilities.
- ✓ Applications accepted year round at any of the locations and sent to the Military Affairs Board Liaison, Financial Services Department.
- ✓ First application review takes place in October by the Military Affairs Board at its November meeting. In December, the recommendations are presented to the City Commission.
- ✓ Second application review takes place by the Military Affairs Board at its May meeting. In June, the recommendations are presented to the City Commission.

Requirements:

- ✓ Must have honorable discharge
- ✓ Proof of military service (DD214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty)
- ✓ Proof of residen
- ✓ Consent to background check
- ✓ Appear at City Commission meeting for presentation
- ✓ Authorize photo on banner
