RESOLUTION 2023-104 PURSUANT TO SECTION 46-288 OF CHAPTER 46 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A FINAL RATE RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A FIRE RESCUE SERVICES ASSESSMENT FOR FY 2023-2024

Summary

This resolution sets the final rates for the special assessment for fire services for Fiscal Year 2024 to be billed to all property owners in the City of Lauderdale Lakes. Advertising for this public hearing appeared on the Truth in Millage (TRIM) Notice mailed to all property owners. Staff recommends approval of the resolution setting the fire assessment for fire services for Fiscal Year 2024 to fund the fire response services.

Staff Recommendation

Background:

At the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, Resolution #2023-093 was approved establishing the proposed rates for the fire assessment as required by Section 46-288.(b) of the City of Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances. Since that meeting, all pertinent charges for services have been finalized and the recommended rates for all land use categories have not been adjusted. The recommended rates for this assessment are included in Exhibit A. The assessment is anticipated to generate \$6,816,918 in revenue towards the Fire Fund.

Fire Assessment Rate Information: It should be noted that this resolution maintains the existing fire rescue assessment rate schedule. The rates recommended for final certification for FY 2024 year are based upon the amount needed to fund the contract with the Broward Sheriff's Office for all fire response and suppression efforts. The Broward County Revenue Collections Division will continue collections on behalf of the City of Lauderdale Lakes.

12 WHEREAS, Chapter 46 of the Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances (“Code of
13 Ordinances”) provides for annual proceedings for the implementation of a Fire Rescue Services
14 Assessment;

15 WHEREAS, Section 46-286 provides for the adoption of a final assessment resolution by
16 the City Commission to establish a final assessment resolution;

17 WHEREAS, the City of Lauderdale Lakes (“City”) has contracted with the Broward
18 Sheriff’s Office(“BSO”) to provide fire rescue services, including fire response, fire suppression,
19 fire prevention, and other services for the enhanced protection of life and property in the City;

20 WHEREAS, all of the real property within the boundaries of the City limits has been
21 determined to receive a special benefit from the provision of services by the fire rescue
22 services provided by BSO to the City;

23 WHEREAS, at the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, the City Commission of
24 the City of Lauderdale Lakes adopted Resolution No. 2022-093 establishing the proposed rates
25 for the fire rescue services assessment as required by Section 46-288(b) of the Code of
26 Ordinances;

27 WHEREAS, since that meeting, all pertinent charges for services have been finalized,
28 and the recommended rates for all land use categories have not been adjusted;

1 WHEREAS, the City Commission, by this Resolution, hereby determines and sets the
2 final rates for the fire rescue services assessment for Fiscal Year 2024 to be billed to all
3 property owners in the City, as described in the attached **Exhibit A**, and such rates are based
4 upon the amount needed to fund the contract with BSO for all fire response and suppression
5 efforts; and

6 WHEREAS, the fire rescue services assessment is anticipated to generate \$6,817,049.63
7 in revenue towards the Fire Fund.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
9 LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF RECITALS: The foregoing RECITALS are hereby ratified and
11 confirmed as being true, and the same is hereby incorporated by reference and made a specific
12 part of this Resolution.

13 SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF FINAL RATE RESOLUTION FOR THE FIRE RESCUE SERVICES
14 ASSESSMENT FOR FY 2023/2024: This Resolution adopts and approves the Final Fire Rescue
15 Services Assessment Rates, as set forth in **Exhibit A** of this Resolution, attached hereto and made
16 a specific part hereof, and as is required by Chapter 46, Section 46-286 of the Code of
17 Ordinances.

18 SECTION 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT:
19 The Director of the Financial Services Department, through the City Manager, is hereby
20 authorized and directed to advise Broward County ("County"), through the appropriate County
21 Divisions, which include without limit, the County Property Appraiser's Office and the County
22 Records, Taxes, and Treasury Division, of the City's final Fire Rescue Service Assessment Rates for
23 FY 2023/2024, and the date, time, and place of the public hearing to consider and establish the

Summary

This resolution establishes the FY 2024 Solid Waste collection fees. Solid waste collection rates are established in the franchise agreement between City of Lauderdale Lakes and the City's waste hauler, Waste Management.

Staff Recommendation

Background:

During the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, Resolution #2023-094 was passed establishing the City's intent to utilize the current billing method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser with a preliminary rate to advertise on the Truth in Millage notice was adopted. The advertised rate represents a not-to-exceed amount.

The Final FY 2024 Solid Waste rate is \$272.00 per residential parcel. This rate is reflected in Exhibit A and it generates \$1,438,880 in revenues for Fiscal Year 2023. This resolution establishes the final rates for solid waste service charges to be collected through the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office (BCPA) only.

Staff recommends adoption of the resolution to fund solid waste services.

10 WHEREAS, Chapter 74, Article II of the Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances governs the
11 collection and disposal of solid waste within the City of Lauderdale Lakes (“City”);

12 WHEREAS, per Section 74-34(c), the grant of a franchise for the collection, hauling, and
13 disposal of solid waste, pursuant to a franchise agreement, is in the best interests of the City;

14 WHEREAS, the City has granted an exclusive franchise to Waste Management, Inc. of
15 Florida, doing business as Southern Sanitation Service and Broward Disposal (“Waste
16 Management”), to collect and remove trash, garbage, and other refuse within and throughout
17 the City for the benefit of the City and its residents (“Franchise Agreement”);

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Franchise Agreement, Waste Management is authorized to
19 charge and collect certain collection and disposal fees;

20 WHEREAS, the solid waste fees are imposed on all residential and commercial properties
21 in the City and are not in excess of the proportional benefits to each property;

22 WHEREAS, the City intends to continue utilizing the uniform method of collecting solid
23 waste fees for single-family residences, pursuant to Florida Statute §197.3632;

24 WHEREAS, the City shall continue to bill and collect surcharges collectable pursuant to the
25 Franchise Agreement on single-family residences by separate billing to the affected property
26 owners, including, but not limited to, optional “back door” pickup services;

1 WHEREAS, all commercial and multi-family parcels will continue to be billed by Waste
2 Management;

3 WHEREAS, during the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, the City Commission
4 adopted Resolution No. 2023-094 establishing, the City's intent to utilize the current billing
5 method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser ("BCPA") with a preliminary rate
6 to advertise on the Truth in Millage notice. The advertised rate represents a not-to-exceed
7 amount;

8 WHEREAS, the Final FY 2024 Solid Waste rate adopted by the City Commission is Two
9 Hundred Seventy-Two and No/100 (\$272.00) Dollars per residential parcel as set forth in the
10 attached **Exhibit A**;

11 WHEREAS, the City Commission, by this Resolution, hereby establishes the final rates for
12 solid waste service charges to be collected through BCPA only;

13 WHEREAS, there is no current-year fiscal impact; and

14 WHEREAS, City staff recommends the adoption of this Resolution, including **Exhibit A**, to
15 fund solid waste collection and disposal services.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
17 LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

RESOLUTION 2023-106 ADOPTING A FINAL RATE AND ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR STORMWATER UTILITY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024

Summary

This resolution adopts the final rates for the provision of stormwater services through Stormwater Enterprise Fund and provides for the continued use of the uniform method of collections. Advertising for this public hearing appeared on the Truth-in- Millage (TRIM) Notice mailed to all property owners.

Staff Recommendation

Background:

At the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, Resolution #2023-095 was adopted establishing the City's intent to continue utilizing the current billing method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser with a rate to advertise on the Truth-in-Millage Notice. The City of Lauderdale Lakes will charge a stormwater fee in the amount of \$6.25 monthly per residential unit. This fee is identified in Chapter 19 of the City of Lauderdale Lakes' Code of Ordinances.

Along with other revenue sources, the total amount to be generated will collectively meet the debt and operational service requirements associated with ongoing and proposed major capital improvement projects.

This item provides for the final certification of the Stormwater Utility Fee Rate to the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office and completes the legislative action needed to finalize billing through the uniform method of collection.

Staff recommends approval confirming the rate and method of collection of the Stormwater Fee. This rate is expressed as an equivalent residential unit rate (ERU) of \$6.25 monthly. The ERU multiplied by twelve equals \$75.00. This resolution seeks to reconfirm the current rate and direct the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office and Broward County's Water and Wastewater Services on the billing method.

11 WHEREAS, Chapter 90, Section 90-54 of the Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances
12 (“Code of Ordinances”) provides for the imposition of stormwater utility user fees;

13 WHEREAS, the City of Lauderdale Lakes (“City”) intends to continue utilizing the uniform
14 method of collecting Stormwater Utility User Fees for single-family dwelling units pursuant to
15 Florida Statute §197.3632;

16 WHEREAS, commercial, industrial, and community facilities will continue to be billed
17 monthly by Broward County, and multi-family dwelling units will continue to be billed quarterly
18 by Broward County;

19 WHEREAS, at the Commission Meeting held on July 25, 2023, the City Commission
20 adopted Resolution No. 2023-095, establishing the City’s intent to continue utilizing the
21 current billing method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser with a rate to
22 advertise on the Truth-in-Millage Notice;

23 WHEREAS, the City will charge a stormwater fee in the amount of Six and 25/100
24 Dollars (\$6.25) monthly or Seventy-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$75.00) yearly per residential unit;

14 The Director of the Financial Services Department, through the City Manager, is hereby
15 authorized and directed to advise Broward County through the appropriate divisions, including
16 the Property Appraiser's Office and the Records, Taxes, and Treasury Division, of the City of
17 Lauderdale Lakes' Final Rate and Assessment Roll for Stormwater Utility Services for
18 FY 2023/2024.
