#### Summary

This resolution sets the final rates for the special assessment for fire services for FY 2025-2026 to be billed to all property owners in the City of Lauderdale Lakes. Advertising for this public hearing appeared on the Truth-in-Millage (TRIM) Notice mailed to all property owners.

#### Staff Recommendation

## **Background:**

At the City Commission Meeting held on July 22, 2025, Resolution #2025-095 approved establishing the proposed rates for the fire assessment as required by Section 46-288.(b) of the City of Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances. Since that meeting, all pertinent charges for services have been finalized and the recommended rates for all land use categories have not been adjusted. The recommended rates for this assessment are included in Exhibit A. The assessment is anticipated to generate \$6,885,715.88 in revenue towards the Fire Fund.

Fire Assessment Rate Information: It should be noted that this resolution maintains the existing fire rescue assessment rate schedule. The rates recommended for final certification for FY 2025-2026 year are based upon the amount needed to fund the contract with the Broward Sheriff's Office for all fire response and suppression efforts. The Broward County Revenue Collections Division will continue collections on behalf of the City of Lauderdale Lakes.

Staff recommends approval of the resolution setting the final assessment rate to fund the fire response services for FY 2025-2026.

#### Summary

This resolution establishes the FY 2025-2026 Solid Waste collection fees. Solid Waste collection rates are established in the franchise agreement between City of Lauderdale Lakes and the City's waste hauler, Waste Management.

#### Staff Recommendation

## **Background:**

At the City Commission Meeting held on July 22, 2025, Resolution #2025-094 was adopted establishing the City's intent to utilize the current billing method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser with a preliminary rate to advertise on the Truth-in-Millage notice. The advertised rate represents a not-to-exceed amount.

The Final FY 2025-2026 Solid Waste rate is \$272.00 per residential parcel. This rate is reflected in Exhibit A and it generates \$1,455,472 in revenues for FY 2025-2026. This resolution establishes the final rates for solid waste service charges to be collected through the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office (BCPA) only.

Staff recommends adoption of the resolution to fund solid waste services.

10	WHEREAS, Chapter 74, Article II of the Lauderdale Lakes Code of Ordinances governs the
11	collection and disposal of solid waste within the City of Lauderdale Lakes ("City");
12	WHEREAS, per Section 74-34(c), the grant of a franchise for the collection, hauling, and
13	disposal of solid waste, pursuant to a franchise agreement, is in the best interests of the City;
14	WHEREAS, the City has granted an exclusive franchise to Waste Management, Inc. of
15	Florida, doing business as Southern Sanitation Service and Broward Disposal ("Waste
16	Management"), to collect and remove trash, garbage, and other refuse within and throughout
17	the City for the benefit of the City and its residents ("Franchise Agreement");
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Franchise Agreement, Waste Management is authorized to
19	charge and collect certain collection and disposal fees;
20	WHEREAS, the solid waste fees are imposed on all residential and commercial properties

Summary

This resolution adopts the final rates for the provision of stormwater services through Stormwater Enterprise Fund and provides for the continued use of the uniform method of collections. Advertising for this public hearing appeared on the Truth-in-Millage (TRIM) Notice mailed to all property owners.

Staff Recommendation

### **Background:**

At the City Commission Meeting held on July 22, 2025, Resolution #2025-093 was adopted establishing the City's intent to continue utilizing the current billing method and providing the Broward County Property Appraiser with a rate to advertise on the Truth-in-Millage notice. The City of Lauderdale Lakes will charge a stormwater fee in the amount of \$6.25 monthly per residential unit. This fee is identified in Chapter 19 of the City of Lauderdale Lakes' Code of Ordinances.

Along with other revenue sources, the total amount to be generated will collectively meet the debt and operational service requirements associated with ongoing and proposed major capital improvement projects.

This item provides for the final certification of the Stormwater Utility Fee Rate to the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office and completes the legislative action needed to finalize billing through the uniform method of collection.

Staff recommends approval confirming the rate and method of collection of the Stormwater Fee. This rate is expressed as an equivalent residential unit rate (ERU) of \$6.25 monthly. The ERU multiplied by twelve equals \$75.00. This rate is reflected in Exhibit A and it generates \$355,725 in revenues for FY 2025-2026. This resolution seeks to reconfirm the current rate and direct the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office and Broward County's Water and Wastewater Services on the billing method.
