Town Hall Meeting: Roads for Economic Vitality (REV) Cycle I Program

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mayor and Commissioners may be attending a Town Hall Meeting: Roads for Economic Vitality (REV) Cycle I Program on Wednesday, May 27, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting will take place at the Hazelle P. Rogers Multipurpose Center, located at 4340 NW 36th Street, Lauderdale Lakes, FL 33319. Two or more Commissioners may be in attendance.

The City of Lauderdale Lakes proposes the NW 29 Street Multi-Use Path Project to modernize pedestrian and cyclist facilities and improve community connectivity, a primary requirement for the Broward MPO's Roads for Economic Vitality (REV) program. The project scope encompasses the installation of approximately 7,400 linear feet of sidewalk, featuring a 9-foot wide, slip-resistant Flexi-Pave multi-use walkway made of composite materials. The path is proposed for NW 29 Street, extending from SR-7 (US-441) to NW 31 Ave, with a secondary segment on NW 33 Ave connecting to Oakland Park Blvd. To maximize safety, the design includes 8 total intersections and 20 crosswalks, specifically incorporating raised intersections (3-way and 4-way) constructed with stamped concrete to increase pedestrian visibility and slow traffic. This infrastructure will provide enhanced access to key local hubs, including the Broward County Library, St. Helen Catholic School, St. Anthony's Rehabilitation Hospital, and surrounding residential communities like Somerset Lakes and Bella Vista.
